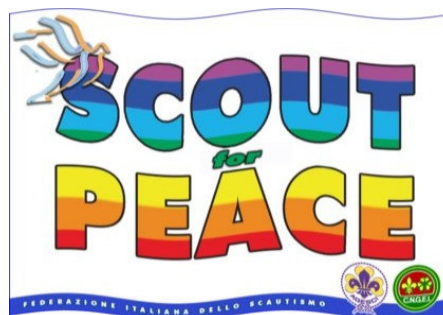

A March for "reopening the road": towards the **Perugia-Assisi Peace March** for a Responsible Peace



The **Italian Scout Federation (FIS)** is offering scouts and guides from all over the world to willful participate in the 2007 Perugia - Assisi Peace March.

This is an event which has been taking place in Italy, since 1961, going from Perugia to Assisi, which is the town of peace. Every two years, associations, movements and other civil society entities that belong to the "Tavola della Pace", organize this event. It is not only a 20-kilometres March. It is also a major opportunity to debate and commit to support peace around the world. The Perugia - Assisi Peace March, which takes place every two years, gathers over 200.000 people, 10.000 of whom are Italian scouts and guides participating in it either as individuals or as scout groups.

This activity, which will take place **7th October 2007**, is offered to all scouts and guides willing to participate and to come to Italy to live this event together with us, thus turning it into an International Peace March.



SAYING, MAKING AND COMMUNICATING PEACE

That was the slogan and the path of the 2nd YOUTH U.N. ASSEMBLY in Terni (central Italy, Umbria) which took place in on 8th, 9th and 10th September 2005.

It was an event that offered the young an occasion to promote their saying, their acting for peace in close relationship with the 6th PEOPLES U.N. ASSEMBLY, which took place in those days in Perugia.

YOUTH U.N. and PEOPLES U.N. are the two initiatives that prepare the "PERUGIA - ASSISI PEACE MARCH" and are peculiar occasions on which the civil society meets to think about and try to build "another" world, free from war and oppression, poverty and exploitation. Around 300 young people from all over Italy and 25 international guests took part in the event coming from: Albany, Bosnia Herzegovina, Brazil, Burundi, Camerun, Colombia, Ghana, Israel, Kenya, Lebanon, Mali, Mozambique, Palestine, Sierra Leone, U.S.A., Ukraine.

It was the right moment to investigate the following three themes:

- Will I have a life long job?
- Who will decide for my life and my future, and how?
- What can I do to build a world better that the one I have inherited?

The meeting was the occasion to make a seriuos comparison between the different experiences, which led to a significant synthesis. This was the contribution to PEOPLES U.N. and handed to the young during the Perugia - Assisi Peace March (11th September 2005)
