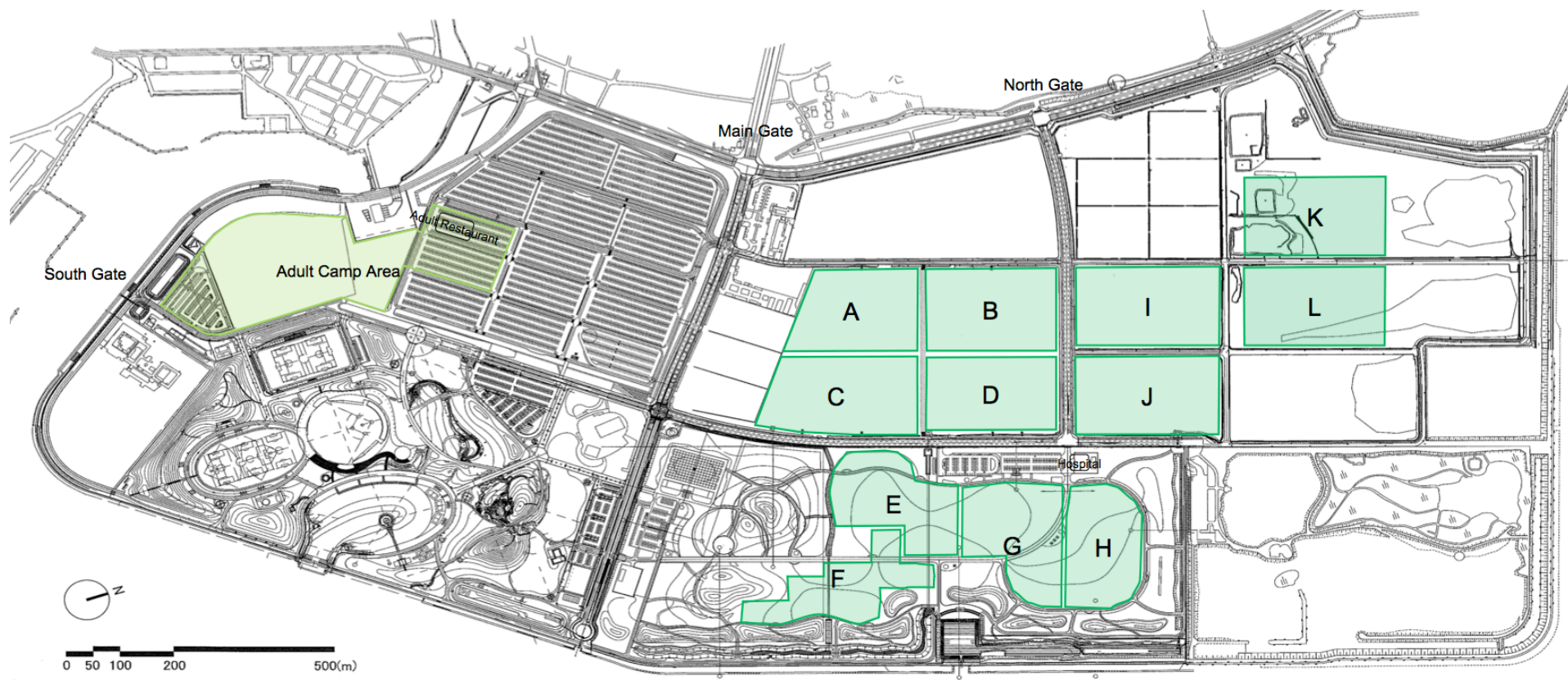
Sub-Camp is the “Home” for Scouts.

Unit Equipment

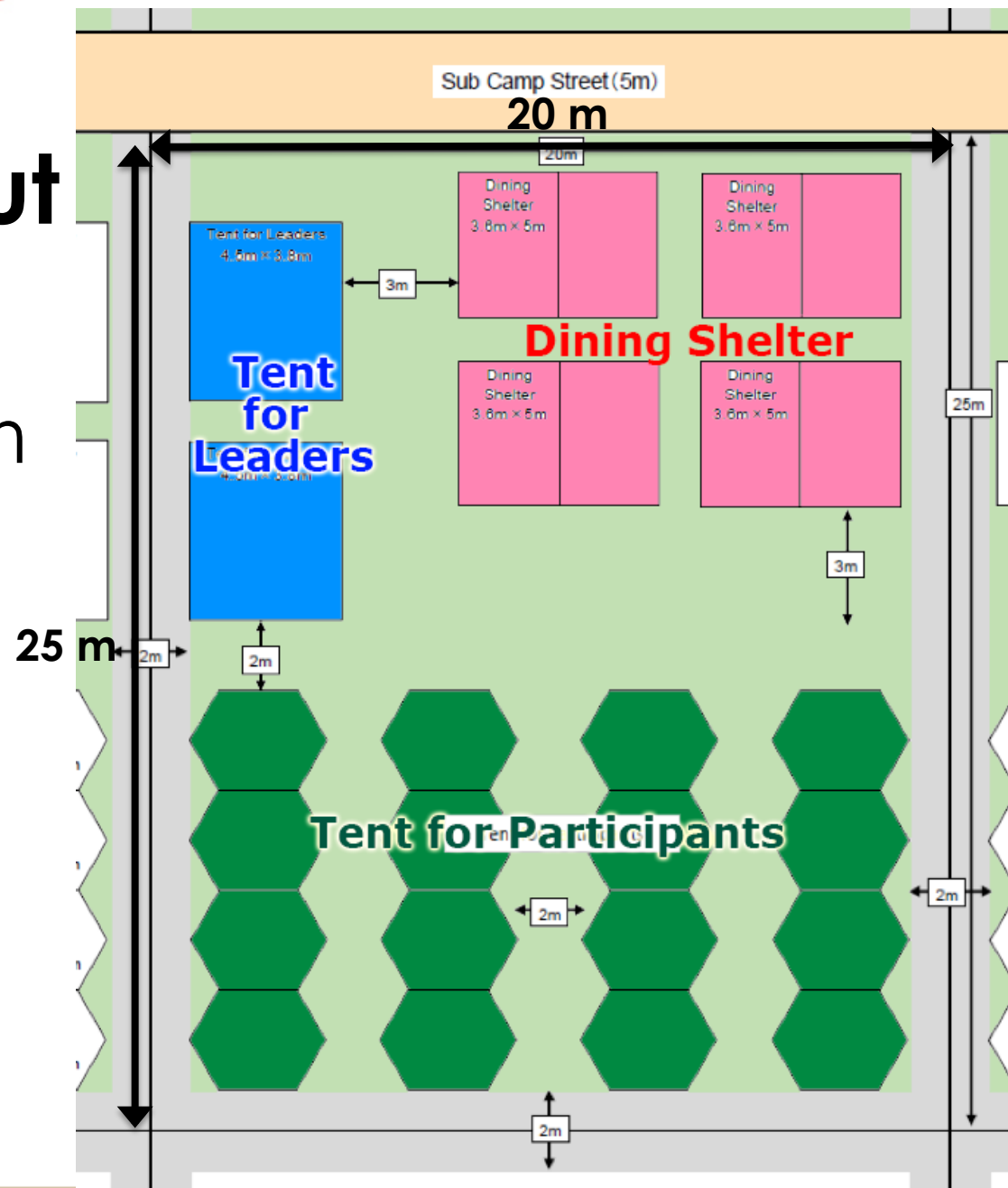
- You must prepare tents
- We offer purchase & rental option
- We provide dining shelter, table and chair, cook wear
- Bring your lighting
- Bamboo & hemp rope to be provided
- You can see tents and cook wears later during the tour

Fire Protection & Site Plan

- Cooking area should face to street
- Cooking area must be separated for 3m from sleeping tents
- 1m clearance from the neighboring sites
- Maximum 10 people allowed in a sleeping tent or a group of tents

Unit Site Layout

- W: 20m, D: 25m
- 40 people/site



Site Regulations

- No Digging
- No Flame
- No cutting of grasses and trees
- No Water Pollution
- Maximum 4m height structure
