# Check-in (continued)


- **Group Check-in** (Unit, CMT and etc.)

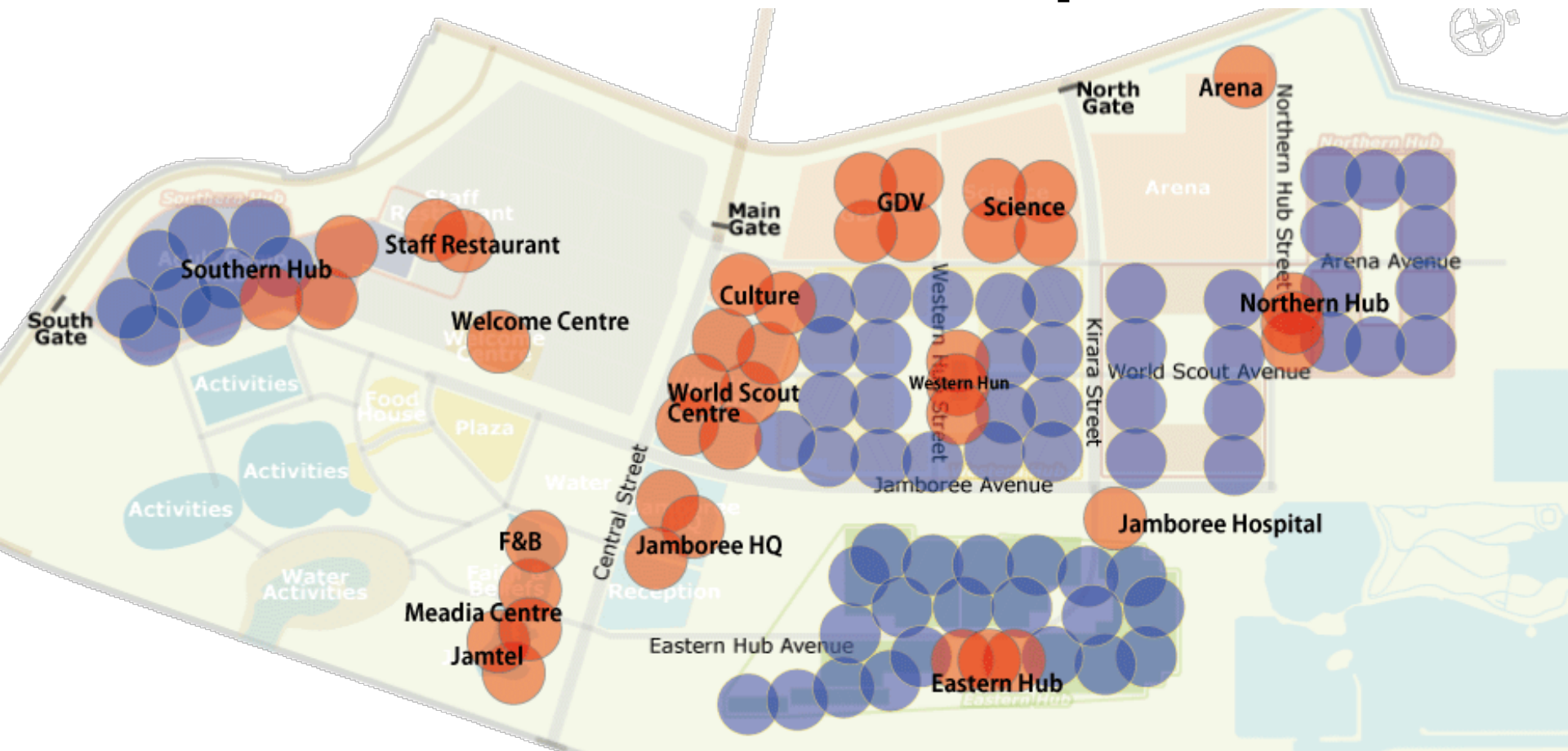
