About 'TA-Q-BIN' Service

- OSize: the combined total of the length, width and height = within 160cm
- Weight = up to 25kg (Size and weight Standards: 1 inch=2.5cm, 1 feet=30cm, 1 pound=0.45kg)
- Airport TA-Q-BIN (sending to airports): required number of days for 'TA-Q-BIN' +1day

Prohibited Items
